The Sporting Tourist is especially catered for. Golfers have the nine-hole course at Waterville (10 miles),

the nine-hole course at Dooks (20 miles) and the famous Killarney Championship Course.

The deep-sea fishing at Valentia is famous. More specimen fish have been taken from Valentia waters than any other fishing centre in the country. River and Lake fishing is available within ten miles of the guest house.

Skin Diving is arranged in conjunction with the Valentia Island Sub-Aqua Club.
