



ERRIGAL (2,466 feet): a beautiful cone of white quartzite, is the highest mountain in Donegal and one of the most sporting climbs in Ireland. The easiest and normal ascent is from a bridge one mile south west to the summit. There are two summits about 30 yards apart, connected by the 'One Man's Path'. From these a magnificent view is obtained, embracing, under favourable circumstances, most of the mountains of Ulster, and the rugged coast for miles to the west.
