

**UNIVERSITY COLLEGE DUBLIN**, with approximately 10,000 students, is the largest university institution in Ireland. Its Charter was granted in 1908 but the College had its origin in the Catholic University of Ireland which opened in 1854 with John Henry Newman as first Rector. The College's **BELFIELD CAMPUS** (300 acres) lies on the southern boundary of Dublin City.
