Institute in Rome, Repertorium Germanicum and other publications (ca 30 volumes).

The library of the Reichsinstitut totals about 45 - 50.000 books and is one of the mort valuatte special libraries for medieval history, esperially of Germany and France. The library of the German Historical Institute at Rome with its 42.000 books is first of all meeting all demants of its special scientific take in Italy.

Early in 1944 both institutes were evacuated into
the castle of Commersfelden to protect them against all
dangers of the war. Here, the Reichsinstitut got its
study in an adjoining building of the castle, so that
it octil carry on its researches by a reduced number
of collaborators up to now without any anterruption.
The library of the Deutsches Historisches Institut"
in Rome, on the other side, was stored in boxes at the
newby farm of Oberköst (belonging to the castle)

As a government of the Reich is no longer existing the Regierungspräsident von Ober- und Eittelfranken at Ansbach, on behalf of the Bavarian Government took the trusteeship of the institutes on August 19th 1945.
